In today's unpredictable world, emergencies and unexpected events can strike anywhere, anytime. From unforeseen natural disasters to acts of violence, being prepared is no longer just an option - it's a necessity.

The First 15 is a combined preparedness and response class that empowers residents to be more prepared for emergencies and to provide life-sustaining care to themselves and others while waiting for first responders. The course is tailored for houses of worship, nightlight and restaurant businesses, local non-profits--and every community group in between.

- Craft an emergency plan tailored to your setting.
