This week's Sunday School lesson continues our discussion of Paul; specifically what follows his "conversion" which we explored last week. The reading this week is from a Letter of Paul to the Romans, chapter 1, verses 1 through 6. After Jesus appeals directly to Paul on his way to Damascus, Saul the persecutor becomes an apostle of the Christian faith. An apostle is "one who is sent forth" - or, a "herald", one who announces striking news. Discuss with your family some examples of apostles in current times. It is also worth discussing the term "false apostle", which is described in II Corinthians, 11-13. A "false apostle" is a term used to describe a person of questionable faith and credentials. I am sure the girls will also be able to describe some examples of false apostles they may have witnessed or perhaps read about.
