

## May 3<sup>rd</sup>: Lesson Plan and Resources

Today, if we were in Sunday School, we would continue talking about Saul/Paul. Like all of us, Paul is a flawed person. Before he begun worshiping Jesus, he was known as Saul, a man who actively sought Jews to persecute them.

The Bible reading for today is Acts 9:3-19, which describes the events that led to Saul's conversion. Talk with your parents about the word conversion. It's a big one. For Paul, his conversion was a whole of life, all encompassing conversion, but during this time of quarantine, you may have experienced some small conversions in your life. For example, you've all been converted to online students. For me, I've become more green -- we only use cloth napkins as opposed to paper. These are small examples. For Paul, his whole way of life changed.
